Goal:

• Installation of the PlagScan plugins in Canvas

Enter the address of <u>Canvas</u> in your browser.

Log on to Canvas with your administrator account.

3

Click on the "Courses"-Button.

Click on any course in the second left side bar.

Click on "Settings".

Click on the tab "Apps".

Enter the address of the <u>plagiarism portal</u> to your browser.

2

Log on to the plagiarism portal with your PlagScan administrator account.

3

Click on "Administration" in the top bar and on "API Integration" in the side bar.

4

Click on the "Generate API key" button.

Tip:

In order to copy your API key double-click on the associated field. Press STRG + C on your keyboard to copy and STRG + V to paste your key to a field.

5

You can find your consumer key at any document you receive from PlagScan.

Tip:

Use Copy & Paste as mentioned above to enter your consumer key.
